**CARBONIN USA ANNOUNCES ITS FIRST-EVER NATIONAL ROAD RACING CONTINGENCY PROGRAM**

Contingency details have been announced for Carbonin USA's 2019 Road Racing season.

SANDPOINT, Idaho - Carbonin USA is pleased to announce details of its first-ever road racing contingency program for the 2019 calendar year. Totaling over \$50,000 in credit contingency awards, the Carbonin Contingency program offers product payout in the form of Carbonin Credit. This applies to the top-three results, in the top 3 classes, in 10 different US club road racing series.

Racers competing aboard bikes with Carbonin Bodywork will have the opportunity to earn the following payout for a top-three finish in each of the participating clubs' premier races for 300's, 600's, and 1000's.

1st - \$100, 2nd - \$75, 3rd - \$50

Eligible riders for contingency payout must meet the following simple requirements:

1. Rider must be using a complete kit of Carbonin bodywork
2. Carbonin Logo on Front fender and Lower Fairing/Belly Pan
3. Rider will post picture of Carbonin clad motorcycle and race results in Facebook/Instagram & tag Carbonin USA, this is only way to notify us of your contingency\*
4. Rider does not have to be original owner of bodywork
5. Supported race grids must have 6 or more competitors for payout.
6. Double Header races will only get contingency for best overall finish

\*It's important to know that notification of results are recorded via social media posts and tagging us, see line item #3.
